Covid-19 Information:

We regret that due to the current health emergency we will not enter bedrooms to clean or tidy during your stay. Books and other items such as magazines will not be available and our study/library is currently not open for guests. We will seek to maintain social distancing for your and our safety during your stay. We will only have one household/bubble of guests in the house at any time and a 72 hour gap between guests in any one room to enable deep cleaning to be carried out. Because of the extra cleaning required and the limited number of guests we can take we ask that you stay a minimum of three nights.

Developing symptoms while you are staying with us

The incubation period for coronavirus is 2 –14 days, so it's possible you could develop symptoms after you arrive. It's vital you let us know you feel unwell as soon as possible. Ideally, if you're able to leave, we will ask you to return home immediately. If this isn't possible (for instance, if you are too unwell to travel) we will ask you to self-isolate. We will contact NHS Wales for the most current recommended next actions, including assisting them with their Test and Trace programme. If you leave early due to illness no refund will be made. We reserve the right to make a daily charge if you stay beyond your departure date.

We have restored the electric servants' bells in the drawing room, dining room and hall (by the red baize door). Don't be reticent - please do ring the bell if you need assistance.

We are a no smoking | no pets | no children household

- **Important** - in an emergency the fire exit route is down the stairs and out the front door

Other bits and pieces

- **Forgotten something?** If you have forgotten toothpaste, toothbrushes or a razor, please ask and we can provide you with a temporary supply. We have available sewing & shoe cleaning kits and can provide an iron and ironing board
- **Mobile phones:** Some networks (O2) have better reception than others. If your mobile does not work here, please don't hesitate to ask us if you wish to make a call on our landline. We make no charge for standard national landline calls. For calls to mobile, premium and international numbers we ask you to estimate the cost of the call.
- **Wi-Fi:** Wi-Fi is free to guests for personal (i.e. non-business) use. Log on to BTHub6-9T3S and insert the pass code (case sensitive):

- **Water:** cold water, from all the taps in the bathrooms, is drinkable. We do not stock bottle water.
- **Comfort:** if you are cold at night there are additional blankets, etc in the wardrobe. The radiators have thermostatic valves to allow you to control the heating. If you are still cool, please ask for an electric heater
- **Security/Front door key:** if you are going out, please check that we will be at home on your return. If not, we will lend you a front door key.
- **Drawing Room** – you are welcome to use the Drawing Room to relax in and read. During the health emergency the study/library is shut.
- **Soaps, etc** – There is a supply of soap, shower gel, toilet paper in your room. If you have any rubbish, please leave outside the room for us to collect. If you need any more soap, etc please ask.
- **Anything else?** if you need anything else to make your stay more comfortable, we will do our best to meet your needs. We are not a hotel and we do not offer room service. But during the day if we are around we are happy to serve tea & coffee (*included in the room price*) or other drinks – we are fully licensed - (*see our wine list*) in the drawing room, study or garden.

Please vacate the rooms by 11am on the day of

departure. If you would like to stay a little longer do ask and we will try to oblige, if we do not urgently need to clean and change the rooms
